

The Villages® Car Club Show Guidelines

The Villages® Brownwood Paddock Square® and Lake Sumter Landing® are the focus of many activities and play an important role in contributing to our friendly, hometown atmosphere. These guidelines are established to ensure the fair, continued, and profitable participation of our valued car clubs in The Villages® Car Club Shows.

1. Venue Space

- **a.** Brownwood Paddock Square®
 - i. Maximum of 31 club cars are allotted around the perimeter of the square.
 - ii. Utilizing all 3 sides of the square
- **b.** Lake Sumter Landing®
 - **i.** Maximum of 53 club cars are allotted around the perimeter of the square.
 - ii. Utilizing all 4 sides of the square

2. Attendance

- a. Brownwood Paddock Square®
 - i. Car club shows take place on select Monday and/ or Friday nights, 5pm 8pm.
 - ii. Club cars will stage in the back parking lot behind Gators Doc Side.
 - **iii.** Leaving a space early without permission is strictly prohibited and may result in forfeiture of future Car Club Show dates
- **b.** Lake Sumter Landing®
 - i. Car club shows take place on select Monday and/ or Friday nights, 5pm 8pm.
 - **ii.** Club cars will stage in the back parking lot behind City Furniture.
 - **iii.** Leaving a space early without permission is strictly prohibited and may result in forfeiture of future Car Club Show dates.

3. Set Up and Tear Down

- a. Cars will be brought into the square from staging area at approximately 4:00pm.
- b. If the Car Club would like to utilize a WHITE 10'x10' tent, weights for tent (a minimum of 25 lb per leg) are required.
 - i. Tent, table, or chair rentals may be available through The Villages Entertainment for an extra fee.
 - ii. Usage of the chairs on the square is prohibited.
- c. Members are not permitted to tie off to any existing structures or landscaping on the squares.



- d. No product storage should take place in any of the landscaped areas. The entire display must be aesthetically pleasing as to reinforce the atmosphere of The Villages.
- e. **There is no power provided for any set up.** Power for tent space/display must be a whisper-quiet generator, a marine battery with an inverter system or battery powered lights.
 - i. Using any of the power outlets found around the squares is strictly prohibited.
 - ii. Generator rental may be available through The Villages Entertainment for an extra fee.
- f. No kerosene, butane, candles, or other flammable products may be used.
- g. No gas cans are to be left in any parking space.
- h. Club members shall bag and remove all or their trash.
- i. Leaving trash, boxes, or bags next to or in the existing trash containers in or around the squares is prohibited.
- j. Non-biodegradable items are to be disposed of properly.
- k. Discarding anything into storm sewers is prohibited.
- l. Outside alcohol beverages on the square is strictly prohibited.
 - i. **NO GLASS** (ex. Wine bottles, whiskey bottles, champagne bottles, bar glasses, wine glasses, etc.)
 - ii. The Square extends to the chained off spaces during a car show.

4. Weather

- a. Weather delays or cancelations are handled on a case by case basis by the manager on site.
- b. Once a Club is set up, they are required to stay until the end of the event unless released by the on-site manager.

5. Solicitation

- a. Solicitation on all squares is prohibited.
- b. Distributing flyers and advertisements outside of your designated tent space is not permitted.

6. Dress Code/Conduct

a. Attire is to be kept clean and neat and shall not be revealing or distracting.



- b. While participating as a club within The Villages, you are a representative of the ideals and image of The Villages and your dress should reflect accordingly.
- c. The use of vulgar language or disrespectful comments will not be tolerated.
- d. Anyone to be found in violation of these rules of dress code and/or conduct will be addressed accordingly.
- 7. All club members must be respectful to all staff and adhere to direction from staff of The Villages and its various partners. These parties are there to assist you and make sure the event is as safe and efficient as possible.

8. Termination Without Cause

a. The Villages Entertainment has the right to terminate any club's right to participate in the Car Club Shows without cause at any time. The Villages Entertainment shall provide written notice should this be exercised.

9. Entire Agreement

- a. As a Car Club representative participating in The Villages® Car Club Show, the club representative and members have read, understands, and agrees to adhere with the Car Club Show Guidelines of The Villages® Entertainment.
- b. The Club acknowledges that any attempt to violate the guidelines or procedures of the Car Club Show events, could lead to the termination of their participation in future events.
